Chişinău International Airport (Romanian: Aeroportul Internațional Chișinău; IATA: RMO, ICAO: LUKK) is Moldova's main international airport, located 13 km (8.1 mi) southeast of the centre of Chișinău, the capital city. It served as headquarters for Fly One, the country's national airline.

On 18 January 2024, the IATA airport code KIV, derived from Kishinev (the Russian and former English name of the city), was changed to RMO (Republica Moldova, "Republic of Moldova" in Romanian)

Chisinau city, the capital of the Republic of Moldova. The first document mention of the topical name Chisinau dates back to 1436. Due to the fact that most of the building have been constructed using limestone, Chisinau is called "the white city". The city is attractive to tourists because of its various buildings of historical and cultural importance, which have earned Chisinau the name of "green city".

In 2010 the restoration of the castle started, and stone by stone, in 5 years, it was restored to its initial state.

Cricova Winery – a true underground wine city with streets bearing the name of varieties of grapes, represents a "wonder of the world" It has an area of 120 km with galleries are at a depth of 35-80m and contains 30 million liters of wine.
