GUIDELINE FOR PRE-OPERATION DISCUSSIONS REGARDING PIERCING-REALIZATION

- Assess the client's capacity to contract. (mental condition, alcohol and/or drug abuse etc.)
- 2. Prepare a declaration of consent form.
- 3. Check the client's majority.
 - Record the number oft he client's legal identity card on the declaration of consent.
- 4. In the case of minority (14 to 18 years) record the legal guardian's number of the official identity card on the declaration of consent -> BGBL. II Nr. 261/2008 § 2 Absatz 1.
- 5. Prevail the client to fill in the declaration of consent form -> BGBL. II Nr. 261/2008 § 2 Absatz 1, 2 und 3.
- 6. Important: Inform the client about possible contradictions! (haemophilia, diabetes, hepatitis, HIV, skin diseases, eczema, allergy, genetic- or autoimmunity diseases, other causes for immunity suppression, blood dilution-therapy, venereal diseases, febrile infects, pregnancy etc.)
- 7. Discuss the choice and placement of the piercing.
 - Check the practicability of the client's choice, if it is not realizable suggest alternatives.
- 8. Deliberate the client regarding piercing jewelry. (kind, material, length etc.)
- 9. Inform the client about the piercing process.
- 10. Inform the client about the healing process.
 - Consider particular circumstances:
 - ° belly piercing -> swimming is not allowed in summer
 - ° nose-piercing -> currently problems with mouth-nose-protection-masks are possible
- 11. Inform the client about possible complications and risks -> BGBL. II Nr. 261/2008 § 2 Absatz 2.
- 12. Piercing process in detail:
 - Performance:

Important: Let the client control the marked placement of the piercing.

Aftertreatment:

Tend the wound carefully and check the client's condition -> circulation etc.

Documentation:

Record performance data and the batch numbers of the used products etc. -> BGBL. II Nr. 261/2008 § 5.

- Provide the client with a final explanation about care-treatment and hand out a written carerecommendation form.
- 14. Arrange a control date.
- 15. Hand out a copy of the declaration of consent.
